DanubeHISTORY

- The Danube flows in Romania along 1,075 km, between Bazias and Sulina
- It is a natural border with the following countries: Serbia for 235,5 km, Bulgaria for 469,5 km, Republic of Moldavia for 0,6 km and Ukraine for 53,9 km.
- Hamangia Culture Late Neolithic archaeological culture (mil IV-II BC) in Dobrogea
- A range of fortresses Dacians and then Roman
- The Danube Commission was established in 1856, with initial name of European Danube Commission, and had its headquarter for almost a century in Romania, in Galați and Sulina.




- Marked hiking routes exist within the protected areas

- Specialities: meatball soup or the tripe soup, meat stew, sarmale, mititei – the little ones, fish, papanaşi, pancakes with cheese filling, cozonac
- Fruit brandy: ţuica or palinca
- Quality wines produced from indigenius and international grape varieties
- The Danube Wine Route, developed within the project Cultural Routes in the Middle and Lower Danube Region, co –funded by the European Commission








ACCESS & ACCOMMODATION

- Water transport: Danube Delta, Iron Gates Area. Main ports: Orșova, Drobeta Turnu Severin, Tulcea, Galați, Braila, Constanta
- Train network, with main stations in Timisoara, Craiova, Bucharest, Fetesti, Tulcea, Constanta
- Air transport with main airports in Timisoara, Bucharest, Constanta
- Road transport: buses, A2- higway Bucharest-Constanta
- Accommodation: total of 1618 accommodation units in the Danube Region. (Datourway, the National Analysis of the Territorial Tourism Strategy for Romania, 2008)













DanubePACKAGES

- There are 18 tour operators, members of ANAT, that offer turist packages in the Danube region
- Most of them are for the Iron Gates and the Danube Delta areas
