DanubeHISTORY

- Danube passes NE Croatia, bordering Hungary and Serbia. Danube in Croatia is about 140km
- Region historically known as Slavonia, two counties at the Danube: Osijek-Baranya and Vukovar-Srijem(Syrmium)
- Former war area but today free and friendly; growing in rural development and tourism

 Vinkovci, Batina, Zmajevac, Bilje, Aljmaš, Karanac















- Castles in Tikveš, Vukovar and Ilok
- Old town centres and fortress of Osijek and Ilok
- Museums in Osijek, Vukovar, Vinkovci and Ilok
- Vukovar War memorial sights
- Worldwide important archaeological places of 'Vučedol' and 'Orion' (new modern archeo museum opening soon)




















DanubeSIGHTS

- Sultans trail, a new historic long distance hiking trail from Vienna to Istanbul
- Follows the Danube in Austria, Slowakia, Hungary, Croatia and Serbia.
- A Dutch initiative, run by volunteers
- The Croatian part is organised with support of the Croatian Tourist Board, local organisations and volunteers

- Sultans trail Croatia, from Draž to Ilok
- About 150 km (7 days walking)

 Sultans trail in Croatia is signposted with stickers and spraypaint,
















DanubeSIGHTS-Sultans trail

- World wonder: the 8 km long Suleyman bridge built in 8 days (Osijek) by the Ottoman empire
- Monuments in Osijek, like foundation of a mosque
- Ottoman ruins in Ilok, like haman or Turkish bath house







meals, čvarci, sweets...












DanubeNATURE

- National nature park 'Kopački Rit' (Danube-Drava), one of the largest wetlands in Europe. About 260 protected birds and other flora & fauna. Great for birdwatchers, hiking, cycling, boat tours, etc.
- Spačva river nature area in Nijemci village; sightseeing by boat
- Other attractive landscapes and viewing points along river
